The spring/summer sale pricing guidelines have been tweaked. The minimum price is now \$4 to receive 50% of the selling price. As in the past, items can be “bundled” with correct ticketing. This information is in the pre-consignment packets and available at consignment.

The success of this sale not only depends on the quality of clothing for consignment, but it also depends on the 270 plus VOLUNTEERS who work the various shifts from set-up on Wednesday, April 27 thru clean-up on Sunday, May 1.
