Annual Book and Author Luncheon a Hit!

This year's Book and Author Lunch was worth waiting for. After being snowed out on February 13, a full house gathered at the Norwich Inn on February 27th to hear Dawn Tripp talk about her fascinating novel *Georgia*, based on the early life of Georgia O'Keefe and her relationship with Alfred Stieglitz. Everyone listened with rapt attention as Tripp explained how she came to write about O'Keefe and talked about the exhaustive research she did for the project. Tripp had just finished the book when, 25 years after O'Keefe's death, her frequent and intimate correspondence with Stieglitz was unsealed and available. Reading the letters led Tripp to a major re-write, although some of the letters were so intimate that they were cut out by her editor.

Although Dawn Tripp is definitely working on another historical novel, she refused to reveal the subject at this point in her writing process. Given the popularity of her talk, we're hoping we can entice her back when the new book debuts. As an aside, she has graciously donated an autographed hard cover copy of *Georgia* to the Gala auction.

The day was an unqualified success. The Inn provided a delightful lunch and everyone went away with an uplifted feeling. If you didn't make the Book and Author lunch this year, be sure to come next year for a bright and shining day in the middle of the winter.

NWC Community Projects: MAY 1st Deadline for Applications

IMPORTANT -- NNS Changes for Spring Sale 2017

The following changes are in place for the Spring 2017 Sale.

- SASE will no longer be accepted. A \$1 deduction will be made from each consignor consignment check for "postage and handling." This will streamline pre-consignment and accounting processes.
- The minimum selling price has been increased to \$5. Pricing guidelines have been adjusted.
- The Bag Sale price increased to \$15 per bag per person to enter.

Pre-consigning on Line – update

On-line pre-consignment contact is Andrea Gaines: NNS.fallspring@gmail.com; on-line pre-consignment numbers are limited to 35 people. Once you have contacted Andrea during the pre-consignment window, she will assign you your consignment number and answer any questions you may have included in your contact e-mail.

On-line pre-consignment window is the same as traditional packet pre-consignment window - March 29 – April 24, however, the on-line pre-consignor MUST submit their spreadsheet by one of two deadline dates: April 15 or April 23 so tags can be printed. This schedule is firm.

On-line pre-consignors' tags and tagging gun will be available for pick-up in Elaine Waterman's entry – 63 Church St (Rt.5N), 8th house on left after white Congregational Church - on April 18 or April 26 depending on spreadsheet submission.

We will no longer be mailing hard copies of the Nearly New Sale announcement as of the Fall 2017 sale.
